**Seniors Course (12th Grade).**

- Young Men or Young Ladies Bible Course
- English IV (Honors)
- Trigonometry/Analytical Geometry\*
- American Government (Honors)/Economics (Honors)

\* Students who take Algebra I in the 8th grade will take Geometry in the 9th grade and so on. Students who take Algebra I in the 9th grade will take Geometry in the 10th grade and so on. Students must take a total of 4 math courses to graduate.

\*\* PBA teaches these courses on a rotating basis from year to year. Students will take these courses in the 9th and 10th grades. These courses must be completed before taking Chemistry in the 11th grade.

\*\*\* Computer Keyboarding/Sport rotates between the 9th and 11th grades when Spanish is not taught. These are required courses.

\*\*\*\* PBA teaches Spanish I and Spanish II on a rotating basis from year to year. When Spanish I is taught, 9th and 10th grade take the course. When Spanish II is taught, 10th and 11th grade take the course.

Note: Trigonometry/Analytical Geometry and all Honors courses are weighted.
