### LIBRARY NEWS: Rules for the PBA Library

Please be aware that if a student is on suspension from the library and there is an assignment due, they **will not** be allowed to use the library until the suspension time is over and the assignment time **will not be** extended. Please be careful to follow to library rules so that you will be able to complete your assignments.

1. No eating or drinking in the library.
2. No excessive noise or talking while in the library.
3. Students must have a pass from their teacher to be in the library.
4. No more than three students from one class may be in the library without their teacher.
5. Library computers may only be used for class assignments.
6. No changing ANY computer settings.
7. The printer and the copier are for school assignments only.
8. No accessing any social network websites.
9. No accessing personal email accounts.

- First Offense:** Suspension from the library for one week.
- Second Offense:** Suspension from the library for two weeks.
- Third Offense:** Referral to the office.
