OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

Operation Christmas Child is the "shoe-box gift" program instituted by Franklin Graham's ministry, Samaritan's Purse, that gives Christian children and adults a chance to "be Jesus" to millions of children across the globe. During chapel students have learned how they and their class can participate in this program. ***Operation Christmas Child Shoe Boxes are due in chapel Tuesday, Nov. 17th (K-5th) and Wednesday, Nov. 18th (6th-12th).**



- Shoe Box: Use an empty shoe box (standard size, please) or small plastic shoe box. Wrapping is not required, but if you do wrap the box, wrap the lid separately.
- Boy or Girl: Determine whether your gifts will be for a boy or girl and choose appropriate gifts in the following age categories: 2-4 yrs., 5-9 yrs., and 10-14 yrs.
- Suggested gifts are: toys, school supplies, hygiene items, hard candy, flashlights with extra batteries, T-shirts, socks, hair clips, etc. Remember to place soap in a plastic bag and candy in double plastic bags.
- **Do NOT include the following:** used or damaged items, war-related items, chocolate or food, liquids, medications or vitamins, breakable items, seeds, aerosol cans and **SNAKES!**
- Pack each shoe box with prayer (I John 5:14) and you may include a picture and personal note.
- Include **your donation of \$7 or more for each shoe box** to cover the cost of shipping and handling. NEW: Find the destination of your box when you give your donation line at www.samaritanspurse.org/ezgive.
- Your family or church can also fill shoe boxes. Peniel is a collection center for our area. Just drop them off at the school!

So, have you completed your shoe box yet? There's not much time left! **Remember, your gift makes a world of difference.**

We pray this new schedule will enhance the communication between you and your child's teacher.

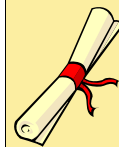

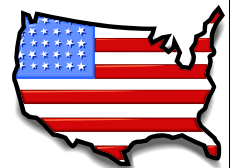
